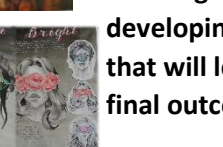
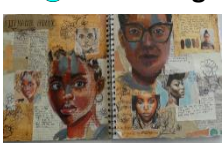


Drawing fish and other sea life from primary and secondary sources
