

Scheme of Learning for Spanish, Years 9-11, 2023-2026

We have recently updated our Scheme of Learning to ensure that Years 9 – 11 access new **grammar** and **vocabulary** at the appropriate time in their learning journey and that they continue to **revisit their skills**. **Phonics** (how to pronounce those tricky Spanish sounds!) are incorporated into each lesson.

Overview:

Year 9 Students consolidate their knowledge of present, past and immediate future tenses, consolidate and extend core vocabulary from KS3 and build confidence in speaking.

Year 10 Students acquire knowledge of imperfect, future and conditional tenses and extend their vocabulary beyond the requirements of GCSE Grade 5.

Year 11 Students use all tenses with increased confidence and recognise all GCSE vocabulary.

Teachers use a combination of the Viva 3 KS3 Spanish course and the Viva KS4 Spanish course, supplemented with their own resources. As in KS3, students will do a Writing Task each half term and will receive feedback.
