


# A Guide to Seneca for Students, Parents & Carers





On the home screen, it will show you:

Below this you will see:


- Your memory palace (store memories on a map and win XP points)

You are able to study every subject with Seneca and the fact that, at Westbourne, we have a premium account provides an even greater range of resources:


- Select **'Add courses'**


Study Seneca gives you the entire course content to study.

Select topics and click continue learning to get started.




## Seneca Premium
