CONSEQUENCE	EXAMPLES OF BEHAVIOUR	FURTHER INFORMATION
C1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disruption to their own learning, or the learning of others. • Making inappropriate comments, noises. • Not responding to teacher instruction. • Out of seat 	Clear verbal warning indicating the unhelpful behaviour. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Positive phrasing - Supervise actively - Encourage - Tackle do not tolerate - Refocus
C2	Failure to respond to the 1 st verbal warning. Student informed that they have now reached a C2 for continued disruption to learning.	Supportive measures: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Move seats - Time out for appropriate students - Use of regulation - Support with task - Set short targets to increase engagement
C3 REMOVAL	Failure of C2 action to have an impact. Rudeness or defiance displayed to staff member. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Display behaviours deemed to be dangerous to themselves or others. • Throwing items with intent around the room • Physical or verbal bullying • Physical interaction with another student • Removing self from the lesson <p>Removal is to a SHADOW Room</p>	<p>Lunch detention with SLT member (20 Minutes)</p> <p>Same day if P1-4, day after in P5.</p> <p>Failure to attend will escalate to an after school detention (45 Min) failure to attend escalation to 1 hour.</p>
C3 DETENTION ESCALATION	Failure to attend 45 Min after school detention will lead to an escalation to a 1 Hr detention. After school detentions will take place on Monday and Thursday.	This is as a result of failing to attend lunch detention after initial escalation to an hour.
NON-NEGOTIABLES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Late to school (AM) • Incorrect uniform, failure to meet uniform expectations. 	Lunch time detention 20min.
